A local law Modifying the Residency Requirements for Codes

SECTION 1. This Local Law is intended to modify the provisions of Section 23 of the Town Law and Section 3 of the Public Officers Law or any other provision of law requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised so that the duly appointed Codes Enforcement Officer of the Town of Stratford may reside in any town in Fulton County or in any County adjacent to Fulton County.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 23 of the Town Law and Section 3 of the Public Officers Law or any other provision of law requiring a person to be a resident of a political subdivision or municipal corporation of the State for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised are waived to the extent that such provisions shall not prevent persons duly appointed as Codes Enforcement Officer in the Town of Stratford from serving as Codes Enforcement Officer in the Town of Stratford, so long as all other qualifications contained in Section 23 of the Town Law and Section 3 of the Public Officers Law are satisfied by the appointee to each such office.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of Secretary of State.
